

PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO CHAPTER 2.60 – RECOGNIZED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS

Purpose - create a framework by which the people of the City may effectively organize into community associations representing a geographic neighborhood or area, or area of interest, and use this as one way to participate in civic affairs and improve the livability and character of the city and its neighborhoods

Key changes

- Broadening the definitions to include all community-based organizations
- Removing reference to SLACC
- Removing the City from the boundary change process

Minimum standards for recognition

- Registered as non-profit with state
- Adopted bylaws
- Open membership and participation
- At least one meeting per year
- At least one meeting per year where a reasonable effort to notify everyone in the geographic boundaries or who may have interest (such as notifying all small business owners in City) about the Association.
- Election process for leadership
- Anti-discrimination provisions
- Where geographically based, the boundaries do not overlap with other Community Associations geographic boundaries.

Registry

- Maintained by the Recorder's Office
- Used for purposes of notification, involvement in city projects and processes
- Information required for registration
- Annual renewal required
